### About NALMCO:

- NALMCO stands for interNational Association of Lighting Management Companies
- It is comprised of companies involved in lighting management services, including lighting maintenance, retrofitting and manufacturing
- Founded in 1953
- There are nearly 150 member companies, representing more than 1,800 individuals
- NALMCO was the first organization in the lighting industry to create nationally recognized professional certifications addressing lighting management
- NALMCO's role in the industry involves providing education, certification and networking opportunities and promoting ethical practices and industry standards
- NALMCO offers three levels of certification:
  - Certified Apprentice Lighting Technician (CALT)
  - Certified Senior Lighting Technician (CSLT)
  - Certified Lighting Management Consultant (CLMC)
- The CLMC, a professional level certification, involves a two-hour exam designed to test an individual's knowledge and experience
- NALMCO hosts two annual events: the fall convention and trade show, a three-day event held in October with lectures by internationally recognized lighting experts; and the Spring Seminar,

which offers training and seminars on industry-related topics -- lighting trends, workplace safety, maintenance practices and technological advances
